ABUSER (Stigma Alert) A person who exhibits impaired control over engaging in substance use (or other reward-seeking behavior, such as gambling) despite suffering severe harms caused by such activity. In experimental research, the word "abuser" was found to increase stigma, which can affect quality of care and act as a barrier to treatment-seeking in individuals suffering from addiction.
