Ohio State History. First explored for France by Robert Cavelier, Sieur de la Salle, in 1669, the Ohio region became British property after the French and Indian Wars. Ohio was acquired by the U.S. after the Revolutionary War in 1783. In 1788, the first permanent settlement was established at Marietta, capital of the Northwest Territory.. The 1790s saw severe fighting with the Indians in Ohio

Civil War Ohio fought on the side of the Union during the Civil War. It was a "free state" that had outlawed slavery. Many slaves had escaped to Ohio through the Underground Railroad prior to the start of the war. Although few battles occurred in the state, many Ohio men fought for the Union army during the war.

History. The area where the city of Kettering now lies was settled from the late 1700s to the mid-1800s, largely as farmland. The population in the area started to grow, prompting the creation of (now defunct) Van Buren Township in 1841. In November 1952, township voters approved incorporating as the Village of Kettering.
