My users wanted SE38 to view source code. I told them to use remote compare from Dev. Now they request SE38 to view program variants, that they create directly in PRD (i.e., not transported). Is there a way to view these without SE38/SA38/SE80?

That is logical and also SAP standard. The solutions can however be very dangerous. a) The user goes to transaction VARCH, selects the report and removes the "Protected" flag. Then others authorized for S_PROGRAM p_action VARIANT of the authorization p_group can maintain it as well, if assigned.
