In cognitive psychology, there is one memory system, but it is normally divided into three functions for storage (Anderson, 2000): sensory, short-term (often called working), and long-term (often called permanent).. Sensory Memory: The sensory memory retains an exact copy of what is seen or heard (visual and auditory).
